The Waynesburg Area Chamber of Commerce is reminding potential scholarship applicants that the application deadline for the 27th Annual Chamber Scholarship and the Dr. Nancy I. Davis Memorial

Scholarship for Educational Leadership in the amounts of \$1,500 is 4:00pm on Monday, April 17th, 2017.

The 27th Annual Chamber Scholarship is open to any Greene County student who will be a graduating senior in 2017. The winner will also receive a laptop, courtesy of **Pcsquared**. The Chamber urges all high school seniors who have been accepted to a College or Technical School as an incoming freshman this Fall and have maintained a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better while in high school to apply for this scholarship.



Waynesburg's Nursing Program Ranked No. 2 in the State

Waynesburg University's baccalaureate Nursing Program was recently ranked No. 2 in the state of Pennsylvania by RegisteredNursing.org.

"We are extremely proud of our nursing program at Waynesburg," said Dr. Nancy Mosser, professor of nursing and chair and director of the Nursing Program. "Our many national and state rankings are a testament to our dedicated, skilled and caring faculty, as well as our hard working and motivated students."

Waynesburg earned a score of 98.64 out of a possible 100. The methodology used by RegisteredNursing.org was based upon analyzing current and historical National Council Licensing Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN) pass rates. Programs reviewed included schools that offer a Diploma in Nursing, Associate Degree in Nursing, Bachelor of Science in Nursing or Direct-Entry Master of Science in Nursing Degree. Waynesburg was

ranked first among the baccalaureate programs evaluated.

Waynesburg's program was one of only two baccalaureate programs in the state of Pennsylvania to achieve a 100 percent pass rate on the NCLEX-RN in 2016. The program has achieved a 100 percent pass rate seven times since 2008.

RegisteredNursing.org's mission is to promote excellence in nursing through enabling future nurses with the tools they need to succeed. The organization is comprised of registered nurses who care deeply about the profession and provide the resources future nurses need to succeed.

Waynesburg's nursing program offers clinical experiences starting the first semester of the sophomore year, a state-of-the-art simulation lab and experienced faculty members. The baccalaureate program is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE). The Department also offers accredited Master of Science in Nursing and Doctor of Nursing Practice degree programs.

Community Builders Honored

Graduates of the Community Builders of Greene County leadership program were recently honored at the Foundation Room of the Community Foundation of Greene County.

Eight individuals received the Community Builders Nonprofit Leadership certification for completing the course on management and leadership of nonprofit organizations. The Community Builder of the Year Awards were presented to Don Chappel, executive director of Greene County Industrial Developments Inc., and Teresa Roberts, board member and co-founder of Second Sam Nine.

Community Builders provides training for people interested in volunteering their time and talents to support Greene County nonprofit organizations. The series is geared to helping citizens become better volunteers with nonprofit

organizations in the community, whether it be through activities, such as serving on nonprofit boards, volunteering on fundraising committees or providing volunteer services.

Greene County Composite Squadron 606 Receives Charter

Civil Air Patrol Greene County Composite Squadron 606 received their charter from the National Civil Air Patrol Headquarters, Maxwell Air Force Bases last month.

Civil Air Patrol, the longtime all-volunteer of the United States Air Force auxiliary, is the newest member of the Air Force's Total Force, which consists of regular Air Force, Air National Guard and Air Force Reserve, along with Air Force retired military and civilian employees.

CAP, in its Total Force role, operates a fleet of 550 aircraft and performs about 90 percent of continental U.S. inland search and rescue missions as tasked by the Air Force Rescue Coordination Center and is credited by the AFRCC with saving an average of 78 lives annually.

Civil Air Patrol's 56,000 members nationwide also perform homeland security, disaster relief and drug interdiction missions at the request of federal, state and local agencies. Its members additionally play a leading role in aerospace education and serve as mentors to more than 24,000

young people currently participating in the CAP cadet program. Performing missions for America for the past 75 years, CAP received the Congressional Gold Medal in 2014 in honor of the heroic efforts of its World II veterans. CAP also participates in Wreaths Across America, an initiative to remember, honor and teach about the sacri-

Pennsylvania Free Enterprise Week



The Pennsylvania Free Enterprise Week (PFEW), will be marking its 39th year this July and August of their award-winning summer program. PFEW was founded specifically to teach high school juniors and seniors about the American private enterprise system and what it means to our country. PFEW now annually holds five sessions in July and August, serving nearly 2,200 students, four on the campus of Lycoming College and a fifth on the campus of Pennsylvania College of Technology, both located in Williamsport, PA.

The focus of each session is to group the participants into management teams of junior executives who have inherited imaginary companies. These teams, under the guiding hands of volunteer “executives-on-loan” called Company Advisors, operate their firms for a computer simulated three-year period of time. They work with balance sheets, statements of income, market share surveys, etc., and must react to a variety of external factors as well.

The Chamber is proud to support PFEW and encourages our local companies and civic organizations to provide sponsorship for our students and, if possible, volunteers for the sessions. Every student attends PFEW on a fully tax-deductible \$575 scholarship (the actual value of the scholarship is about \$1,500) which is provided by a local firm. Each student wears the name of their sponsor throughout the week and writes them after graduation to report on what they have learned. PFEW is also an approved organization through the PA Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) program.
