

### Chamber Announces Chamber Scholarship Winners

The Greene County Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Fund Committee has announced that the 28th annual scholarship will be awarded to Aubree A. Ferek of Carmichaels. Aubree is a graduating senior at Carmichaels Area High School. Seventeen year old Aubree plans to attend Slippery Rock University to purse a degree in Exercise Science/Pre-Physician Assistant Program. She is the daughter of Ron and Brenda Ferek of Carmichaels.

This scholarship, the twenty-eighth for the Chamber, is presented each year to a Greene County senior who plans to attend a college, university or trade school. The scholarship is awarded based on grade point average and an essay. In addition to the scholarship, Aubree will also receive a laptop courtesy of John Frownfelter, owner of PCsquared to use during her college career.





The Chamber also announced that it will award the first "Dr. Nancy I. Davis Memorial Leadership Scholarship" to Matthew P. Komula of Rices Landing. Matthew is employed by the Trinity Area School District and is a 1992 graduate of Duquesne University and a 2009 graduate of the University of Phoenix. He is currently enrolled at Kent State University seeking his Master of Music, Music Education degree.

The scholarship was established to honor the memory of Dr. Nancy I. Davis who was an educator and advocate for education. In 2016 and 2017, the annual GreeneScene Road Rally, presented exclusively by Fox Ford of Waynesburg, raised funds for the scholarship awards. Applicants were required to submit a narrative on how they have demonstrated leadership in education and a list of their local community involvement. The program is open to any Greene County resident who is enrolled or

accepted in an undergrad or grad program.

The scholarships will be presented at the May General Membership Networking Luncheon set for Wednesday, May 30th at Waynesburg University's Benedum Dining Hall. This year, thirty-three applications for the Educational Fund scholarship and thirty-six for the Dr. Nancy Davis scholarship were received. The committee had a difficult task of selecting the winners from the qualified field candidates. The Chamber of Commerce would like to thank all who participated in the process.


### \$1,850 in Gift Cards for Back to School Raffle

New Long Term Substance Abuse Treatment Program

### WASHINGTON HEALTH SYSTEM Greene

Washington Health System through its wholly owned subsidiary Greenbriar Treatment Center provides inpatient, outpatient, residential, and half-way house treatment programs for persons with chemical dependency. Washington Health System also provides in-patient and outpatient behavioral health services at its hospitals in Waynesburg at WHS Greene and in Washington at WHS Washington Hospital. Washington Health System, including Greenbriar Treatment Center, has taken an active role to address the opioid crisis by partnering with community organizations, elected officials, the Washington County Drug and Alcohol Commission and county task forces in both Greene and Washington County. Efforts have included physician education, promoting standardized pain management protocols and adopting prescribing standards aimed at reducing the opioid crisis.

After a thorough review of its addiction services and other behavioral health services, Washington Health System plans to take the following additional steps to help further combat the opioid crisis and meet the behavioral health needs the residents of Greene and Washington Counties.

- Greenbriar Treatment Center will establish a long-term residential treatment program (3C program) for persons undergoing treatment for chemical dependency. It will be the first of its kind in Southwestern Pennsylvania. This program will accept patients from across the region but priority will be given to the residents of Greene and Washington Counties. This 3C program will treat patients in a supervised environment for up to 100 days in order to promote adjustment to new life skills. Funding of the program is subject to discussions with managed care payors in the region.
- Greenbriar's 3C program will be located in the space at WHS Greene currently occupied by the inpatient behavioral health unit.

- Washington Health System is investing \$250,000 to make renovations and improvements to the facility to accommodate the 28 bed program.
- Inpatient behavioral health services will be provided by the Washington Hospital behavioral health unit, which will give priority to patients of Greene and Washington Counties.
- Outpatient behavioral health services will continue to be provided Washington Health System in Waynesburg under the supervision of Richard Ajayi MD.
- Dr. Ajayi and Drs. Oscar Urrea and Camilla Aponte, will be the physicians attending to patients in the Washington Hospital behavioral health unit.
- Medical supervision of the new 3C program will be by Greenbriar Treatment Center Medical Director John Six, MD.

### University and EQT dedicate Waynesburg Unity Trail

Waynesburg University, in conjunction with the EQT Foundation, hosted a dedication ceremony for the Waynesburg Unity Trail Wednesday, April 25. Completed in 2017, the trail project was funded through a \$20,000 grant from the EQT Foundation, the philanthropic arm of EQT Corporation.

A dedication sign at the beginning of the trail reads, "Built by the students of Waynesburg University to promote creation care and cooperation with the Borough of Waynesburg."

The Waynesburg Unity Trail consists of approximately 2 square miles, including 1.5 miles of walking trails and wooded areas that will be preserved for student research and environmental restoration.

The University's goal is for the trail to be a safe place for students to learn, research and spend time with nature, while also offering the greater Waynesburg community the opportunity to enjoy and appreciate nature in an urban setting.





Over the last two years, WHS Greene has made significant improvements to our facility, technology and patient care procedures.
