










5 Kidz Kandy



University Ranked in the Top 5 Percent for Value Nationwide



Waynesburg University was recently recognized as a "Best for the Money" school by College Factual for the third consecutive year. Ranked at No. 20 out of the 1,510 schools considered, Waynesburg placed in the top 5 percent nationwide.

"As we continue to be nationally recognized as a best value school, we are delivering on our promise to offer students an affordable, quality education," said President Douglas G. Lee. "These rankings are a testament to the hard work of everyone at Waynesburg University."

College Factual ranks schools for best value by estimating the actual average cost for an undergraduate degree, using the quality results from the best colleges ranking and personalized factors, such as location, cost and financial aid.

Waynesburg also placed in the top 5 percent for value in the Middle Atlantic region, ranked at No. 3 out of 289 schools. In the state of Pennsylvania, of the 112 schools on the list, Waynesburg was ranked No. 2.

The University was recognized nationally as a top 1 percent "Best Value" for Nursing, ranked at No. 4 out of the 500 school nursing programs ranked for value. Additionally, Waynesburg was awarded a top 5 percent "Best Value" standing for Communication & Journalism, Criminal Justice and Psychology.

Earlier this fall, Waynesburg was ranked at No. 6 on U.S. News & World Report's Regional Universities North list and was named to MONEY Magazine's 2018 "Best Colleges For Your Money" list, ranking third in the region.

Greene County 4-H Educator National Award Winner



Christina Becker, 4-H Extension Educator with Penn State Extension in Greene County and member of the professional association National Association of Extension 4-H Agents, received a national NAE4-HA award for radio spots airing on Waynesburg's WANB Radio Station. Becker was recognized recently at the annual NAE4-HA conference held this year in Columbus, Ohio.

Becker was chosen as the national winner in the radio category of Communicator Awards. Her entry, of 2 weeks of recorded Extension 4-H radio announcements, was selected from a pool of national finalists from four regions across the United States that advanced to the national level from their home states and regions. Becker's radio spots were aired as part of the Penn State Extension Announcements segment on WANB weekdays at 7:30 am. Her announcements provide information about 4-H and often include 4-H members who share their excitement about the program. The Penn State Extension Announcements segment is sponsored by Waynesburg Milling Company in Waynesburg, PA.
