The Greene County Chamber of Commerce is now accepting applications from graduating seniors for the 30th

Annual Chamber of Commerce Scholarship they will award this May in the amount of \$2,000. In addition, the winner will receive a Laptop compliments of PCsquared in Waynesburg and a custom embroidered backpack from the Greene County United Way. The scholarship program is open to any Greene County resident who will be a graduating high school senior in 2020.

The Chamber urges all high school seniors who have been accepted to a College or Technical School as an incoming freshman this Fall and have maintained a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better while in high school to apply for this scholarship.

Applicants will be required to write an essay and furnish a listing of their school activities and local community involvement. Applications are available to be printed directly from the Chamber website at www.greenechamber.org. The top scoring applicants will be interviewed by a panel of judges as part of the application process.

Completed applications must be submitted by 3:30pm on Monday, April 1st. The winner will be announced in early May and the Scholarship Award presented at the Chamber's monthly General Membership Luncheon on May 27th at Waynesburg University.

We hear it all the time – "I can't find great employees!" With the improving economy, many of our members are having trouble finding people with the knowledge and skills they need to help their business grow and thrive. We have a solution – Pennsylvania Free Enterprise Week (PFEW). This award-winning summer economics education program has benefitted our local students for over 40

years. PFEW immerses rising high school juniors and seniors in the

world of business, allowing them to experience firsthand what you face each day. Offered by the Foundation for Free Enterprise Education, PFEW was founded to teach students about the American private enterprise system and help students develop skills that make them the great employees and employers of the future. PFEW annually holds five week-long sessions in July and August on the campuses of Lycoming College and the Pennsylvania College of Technology in Williamsport, PA, serving nearly 2,100 students and 200 volunteers each year.



PFEW participants form teams of approximately 18 students and one volunteer adult




business mentor who become the simulated management team of an underperforming manufacturing company in direct competition with other student companies. Each company must determine, through 12 business quarters, their selling price, marketing costs, production levels and budgets, banking needs, R&D costs and more. In addition, teams must develop a marketing strategy, create a print and media campaign, and design a website. Sound familiar?

The Chamber has proudly supported PFEW for many years, and we encourage all our local companies and civic organizations to provide sponsorship for our students and, if possible, volunteers for the sessions. Every student attends PFEW on a fully tax-deductible \$625 sponsorship (the actual value of which exceeds \$1,500) which is provided by a local firm, foundation, civic organization, or individual. PFEW is an approved Educational Improvement Organization through the PA Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) program. Sponsorship donors are prominently recognized in several publications circulated throughout the state, and each student wears the name of their sponsor on their photo ID badge throughout the week. Students write their sponsors after graduation to report on what they have learned.

The Foundation for Free Enterprise Education, in cooperation with the SIFMA Foundation, offers another award-winning economics education program called the Stock Market GameTM (SMG). SMG is an exciting, interactive game that teaches students in grades 4-12 about investing, global capital markets, and personal finance, leading to long-term financial freedom. Each school year, this program serves over 8,000 students statewide.



2020 Federal Poverty Guidelines Announced

Issued date: 02/25/20

HHS recently announced the 2020 Federal Poverty Level (FPL) guidelines which, among other things, establish the FPL safe harbor for purposes of the Affordable Care Act (ACA) employer mandate. For 2020, the FPL safe harbor is \$103.99/month in the lower 48 states, \$129.99/month for Alaska, and \$119.64/month for Hawaii.

As a reminder, a plan can use poverty guidelines in effect within 6 months before the first day of the plan year for purposes of affordability. As the FPL guidelines were announced after the start of the calendar year, plans beginning on January 1, 2020 use \$101.79/month for the lower 48 states (\$127.14 Alaska and \$117.19 Hawaii), which is 9.78% of the applicable 2019 FPL. The increased threshold applies to plan years beginning on or after February 1, 2020.

Background

Large employers may be subject to the employer penalty under the ACA if they do not offer affordable, minimum value coverage to all full-time employees and at least one full-time employee receives a subsidy in the Marketplace. The FPL is relevant to this penalty in two ways:

Affordability Safe Harbor

For affordability purposes, a large employer satisfies the FPL safe harbor with respect to an employee for a calendar month if the employee's required contribution for the large employer's lowest cost self-only coverage that provides minimum value does not exceed 9.5% (as indexed) of a monthly amount determined as the FPL for a single individual for the applicable calendar year, divided by 12.

2. Subsidy Eligibility

An individual is only eligible for a subsidy in the Marketplace if he or she is within 100-400% of the FPL and is not offered affordable, minimum value group coverage.

Affordability Safe Harbor and Subsidy Eligibility 2019 Results

Based on new 2020 levels:

- For affordability safe harbor purposes, the applicable FPL is the FPL for the state in which the employee is employed.
 The FPL is \$12,760 for a single individual for every state (and Washington D.C.) except Alaska or Hawaii. So, if the
 employee's required contribution for the calendar month for the lowest cost self-only coverage that provides minimum
 value is \$103.99 (9.78% of \$12,760/12) or less, the employer meets the FPL safe harbor.
- For subsidy eligibility purposes, the applicable FPL is the FPL for the state in which the employee resides. 100 400% of the FPL is \$12,760 \$51,040 for a single individual and \$26,200 \$104,800 for a family of four for every state (and Washington D.C.), except Alaska or Hawaii.
