# 32nd ANNUAL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS NOW AVAILABLE

The chamber is now accepting applications from graduating seniors for our 32nd Annual Chamber of Commerce Scholarship they will award this May in the amount of \$1,500. Hot Mops Cleaning Inc. started in the Spring of 2019 with Jacki Cupples as the owner. The business currently has 8 employees, is located in Carmichaels, PA and services Greene County and surrounding areas but will travel for big jobs.

"I was a single mom for a number of years before I met my husband, Jimi Cupples who is the Team Lead in our Realty/ Demo department. I always cleaned on the side for extra income. Eventually, more and more people started asking me to clean their homes. So from that, I insured myself and



started a cleaning company....and here we are today. We currently clean almost 60 homes routinely, clean 9 businesses routinely, and do about 75 deep cleans per year. And we are looking to grow!"

They offer residential and commercial routine cleanings, deep cleaning, move in/out

cleanings, small demo jobs, and full house cleanouts (move out all furniture and belongings in a real estate property). They are also insured and bonded. In 2020, they came in 2nd place for the Observer-Reporter's Best of the Best contest, and came in 1st place in 2021. They hope to continue this for years to come.




