

Waynesburg University recently held its annual commencement exercises honoring approximately 615 graduates. The Honorable Cheryl L. Allen, Superior Court of Pennsylvania judge, delivered the address, "Character, Conviction and Commitment."

Waynesburg University awarded the Master of Arts in Counseling Psychology degree, the Master of Arts in Teaching degree, the Master of Business Administration degree, the Master of Education degree, the Master of Science in Nursing degree, the Bachelor of Arts degree, the Bachelor of Science degree, the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree, the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree, the Associate of Science in Allied Health degree, and the Associate of Science in Business Administration degree.

Prior to commencement exercises, retired chaplain Colonel Alvin "Sonny" Moore delivered the baccalaureate address, "Your Credo," to graduates and their parents.

In addition to honoring its graduates, the University celebrated the dedication of the Fitness Center on Saturday, May 16. The Fitness Center officially opened on Friday, February 6, and offers students, faculty and staff, an additional 16,000 square feet and a variety of new cardio and strength-training machines. 
