#### Southwest Regional Medical Center Adds Behavioral Health Program

Program will add an additional 15 beds to facility

Southwest Regional Medical Center will begin accepting referrals for its new inpatient behavioral health program beginning July 1. This program will add 15 beds and occupy a space in the facility that has been empty for over 7 years. Outpatient Behavioral Health Services will also be available.

Referrals will be accepted from Physicians, nurses, family members, clergy, nursing and assisted living homes, social workers, law enforcement or others concerned about the mental health of individuals 45 years or older. Individuals may also seek services on their own.

All patients will be assessed by licensed psychiatrist, Dr. Ravindra Mehta, medical director of the program. Dr. Mehta is board certified in psychiatry and geriatric psychiatry.

All patients admitted to the inpatient program will receive 24-hour day supervision in a therapeutic environment. Components of treatment include psychotherapy, problem solving group activities, and life skills classes.

The outpatient program will provide a less restrictive treatment option for those needing care. These patients will receive an individualized treatment and discharge plan including recommendations for after care follow up and community resource integrations. Services offered will be:

- Individual and Family Therapy
- Group Psychotherapy
- Physical/Occupational/Speech Therapy
- Medication Management
- Psychiatric and Medical Evaluation
- Memory Impairment Assessment
- Psychological Testing
- Clinical Social Work Assessment
- Recreational Therapy
- Discharge Planning

Founded in 1907, Southwest Regional Medical Center is a community–based 74 bed hospital, providing 24 hour emergency services, comprehensive surgical services, diagnostic imaging, laboratory, physical therapy, cardiology and home health services

in addition to its skilled nursing and behavioral health units.


