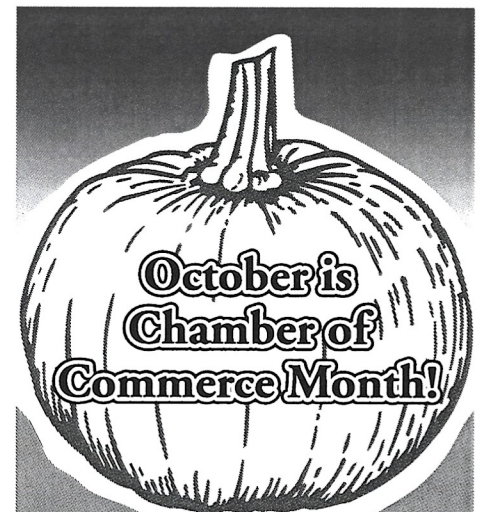

Members in the Spotlight



The Baily Insurance Agency was featured with a picture and article in the 1907 historic publication, *Waynesburg Prosperous and Beautiful*. Below is an excerpt.

"This is the largest and oldest insurance, real estate and loan agency in the County having been established in 1880. They represent the largest and best fire insurance companies in America and their patrons have the benefit of their experience of years in business."

A lot has changed in Greene County in the 99 years since this was published, but the Baily Agency is still here and the basic message in the article is still true today. The agency has expanded its operations several times. Charles Baily, Sr. opened up a Washington office in 1973. The Stanley Headlee Agency was purchased in 1977, and the Doug Lee Agency in 1987.

Baily Real Estate Agency, run by Karl Baily, brought a new name to Greene County in 1994 by affiliating with the national real estate network, Coldwell Banker. Karl is also one of only two State Certified Residential Appraisers in Greene County.

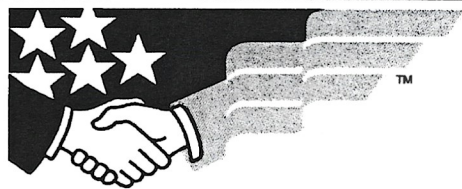

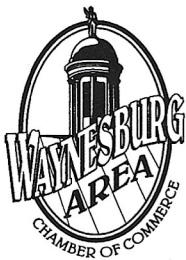
