

Television History Remembered on 71st Anniversary

On September 30, 1939, Waynesburg University (then Waynesburg College) played a game of football that would change television history. Forty-two Waynesburg, players and coaches traveled 400 miles with a convoy of cars to Randall's Island, N.Y., to take on Fordham University at Triboro Stadium. The Yellow Jackets landed in the history books after their Sept. 30 game against Fordham, as it was the first televised college football game in history. The game, televised by NBC, spanned a 50-mile radius, making it impossible for the Yellow Jacket fans situated in Waynesburg to witness the historic game. The broadcast signal reached nearly 1,000 sets in the New York metropolitan area. According to a Yellow Jacket article "...the science of television has not been perfected to the point where the broadcast can carry any great distance." Instead, those who could afford a \$600 set witnessed history in the making.

The telecast was done in conjunction with the RCA/NBC pavilion at the 1939 New York World's Fair. Many accounts refer to this game as the first televised football game.

John Stefanik, a Waynesburg alumnus who is now 91 years old, admits that many of the Waynesburg players approached the game just like they would any other day. "We didn't feel different," he said. "We didn't realize what we had done until several years later." NBC broadcasted the game with one camera, as announcer Bill Stern made the historic call.


