University presents \$10,000 to Waynesburg Franklin Township Volunteer Fire Company

Waynesburg University, represented by Roy Barnhart, senior vice president for Finance & Administration, recently presented Waynesburg Franklin Township Volunteer Fire Company Fire Chief Jeff Marshall with a check for \$10,000. The donation is the University's third \$10,000 installment toward the cost of the Company's Mobile Live Fire Training Simulator. In 2008, Waynesburg University pledged \$50,000 toward the \$583,690 cost of the Simulator. The Simulator was purchased as a result of the lack of training facilities within the company's response area. It offers complex training for senior members and realistic scenarios for new recruits. The simulator is available for use by any of the 16 companies throughout the County. The Simulator allows the Waynesburg Franklin Township Fire Company the ability to offer training related to fire attack, search and rescue operations, use of personal protective equipment, execution of mayday procedures for emergency evacuations, vision obscured environments, ladder operations and confined space techniques, among many other scenarios.

New Scholarship for WCCC Greene County Education Center Students

Students enrolled at the Westmoreland County Community College Greene County Education Center will have a new scholarship available this fall thanks to donations by the Greene County Commissioners and an anonymous donor. Commissioners Pam Snyder, Archie Trader and Chuck Morris presented WCCC President Daniel J. Obara with a \$25,000 check



to establish a scholarship fund for WCCC Greene County Education Center students. That donation, along with a matching contribution from an anonymous donor, will fund the Windy Ridge Retreat/Allegheny Power Greene County Center Scholarship. Half of the fund will be endowed and the remainder will be available for student scholarships this fall. The scholarship will award \$500 per student for tuition and books. To be eligible, students must have three years of immediate past residency in Greene County and be enrolled in one of the following areas of study: business, education, health care, information technology or sciences. Students must complete and submit an application as well as the FAFSA form by May 1.
