

\$1,500 Chamber Of Commerce Scholarship Applications Now Available

National Labor Relations

Effective April 30, 2012, most private sector employers must post a notice of employee rights under the National Labor Relations Act at their worksites. Employers must also provide a link to the notice from the internal or external website if they routinely use the site to inform employees of personnel rules or policies. The 11 x 17 NLRB notice is free and can be downloaded and printed from the website at www.nlrb.gov/poster, or ordered by calling 202-273-0064. In addition, the requirement can be satisfied by purchasing an all-in-one poster from a commercial vendor. The notice will help employees better understand the law and avoid misunderstandings. It is similar to other workplace postings that describes worker's rights. For further details visit http://www.nlrb.gov/faq/poster.

February Networking Luncheon


