The Chamber is reminding area seniors that the application deadline for the 20th Annual Chamber Scholarship in the amount of \$1,500 is 4:00pm on Wednesday, April 14th.

This is the twentieth year that the Waynesburg Area Chamber of Commerce has awarded the scholarship. The scholarship program is open to any Greene County student who will be a graduating senior in 2010. This year the scholarship is being underwritten by Alpha Natural Resources.

All high school seniors who have been accepted to a College or Technical School as an incoming freshman this Fall and have maintained a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better while in high school are urged to apply for the scholarship. Members in the Spotlight


