#### FLASHLIGHT DRAGS TO BE HELD

Flashlight Drags, the legal alternative to street racing, will get motors revving again this spring and summer at the Greene County Airport in Waynesburg. Street legal cars and trucks are eligible to race and all drivers must have a current driver's license, registration and proof of insurance. The 1/8 mile long

race takes place on the airport runway and launches from a special concrete "launching pad" installed in the tarmac. Drivers can race as many times as they want and against any other racer, all



for fun! The name of the event refers back to the early days of drag racing, when a flashlight was used to signal the start. The Flashlight Drags began in Greene County in 2007. In 2008 the Bureau of Aviation mandated that municipal airports could not host non-aviation events. Thanks to the hard work of the Greene County Commissioners, a waiver was received and racing resumed in 2010. The first Flashlight Drag is scheduled for May 5 and more will follow on June 2, July 7, August 4 and September 14. Gates open at noon and the racing begins at 2:00pm. Admission is \$5 to watch and \$25 to race. Children under 12 are admitted free.

#### WCCC Culinary Students win Regional Knowledge Bowl for Fourth Consecutive Year

Westmoreland County Community College culinary arts students and a WCCC alumna earned top awards at the American Culinary Federation Northeast Regional Conference held March 18-20 in Verona, New York.

For the fourth consecutive year, a team of WCCC students won the Northeast Region Baron H. Galand Culinary Knowledge Bowl that tested their knowledge of nutrition, safety and sanitation, and the art of modern cooking. The WCCC team was the top seed and played four undefeated rounds in the "Jeopardy"-style competition to win a gold medal. Securing the regional conference title qualifies the team to compete at the ACF national convention which will be held this July in Las Vegas.

Also at the conference, WCCC culinary arts alumna Tammy Fuchs won the ACF Northeast Region Pastry Chef-of-the-Year award and will also advance to the national competition in Las Vegas. Fuchs is the executive pastry chef at the Rolling Rock Club in Ligonier and also teaches part-time at WCCC.
