

#### 5 KIDZ KANDY'S RAIN DAY RAFFLE BENEFITS K-9 UNIT

As the sign above the store front indicates, the recently opened 5 Kidz Kandy in downtown Waynesburg specializes in candy, coffee, baked goods, fudge, fundraising, ice cream and gifts. While all of the sweets are sure to be a big hit this summer, for Waynesburg Borough police officer Asa Winters and his police dog Izzy, it is the store's specialty in fund raising that is most truly sweet. On July 29th, 5 Kidz Kandy held a raffle as part of the Rain Day festivities in order to raise money for the police department's K-9 unit. The prizes being raffled off included a giant stuffed dog, similar in appearance to Izzy, and a gift basket of chocolate and fudge. 5 Kidz' co-owners Kristy Vliet and Pansy McConnell were able to raise \$165 for the K-9 unit with the raffle. Winters said he is grateful for 5 Kidz' charitable efforts in financially supporting the K-9 unit. The money will be deposited into a general account which may be used for any number of things that K-9 unit may need, such as new training equipment, vehicle maintenance, and so on. Winters has been working with Izzy since March of 2013 and believes she is a good for the police department. The donated money from the raffle is appreciated because donations are a vital part of keeping the K-9 unit up and running. Izzy, now four years old, works hard and has assisted in arrests, making her a valuable member of the police department. To show that the work that Winters and Izzy have put in has not gone unnoticed, the 5 Kidz' staff decided to show their support for the K-9 unit through the Rain Day raffle. When Vilet and McConnell discovered that Winters could use more funding for the K-9 unit, they were inspired to help out. Furthermore, the women saw the police department's K-9 unit as a worthy recipient for their raffle because they felt that police canines often tend to get overlooked. Though the women were hoping to raise a little more, Vilet estimates that around 80 people participated in the raffle. Vilet and MConell are planning to continue to hold raffles to benefit different causes; they will be raffling off another large stuffed animal and gift basket at the Annual 50's Fest in downtown Waynesburg on September 13th.








