Jackie and Pat are seen here attending the Pennsylvania Association of Convention and Visitors Bureaus (PACVB) 23rd Annual Travel & Tourism Legislative Dinner. Travel and Tourism is Pennsylvania's second largest industry and the economy impact on Pennsylvania is:

- \$22.9 Billion Visitor Spending in Pennsylvania
- 424,700 jobs for Pennsylvanians
- \$7.4 Billion Annual Wages and Salaries earned in PA
- 1.8 Billion Tax Revenue for State, Local and Federal Government

Tourist Promotion representatives were in attendance to ask Pennsylvania Legislators to support \$12,000,000 in Matching Funds for Tourist Promotion Agencies Matching Funds Grant, distributed and matched by county and regional Tourist Promotion Agencies and Convention & Visitors' Bureaus in Pennsylvania. Pennsylvania now ranks 4th as a "tourist state" in the U.S.

National Tourism Week in Pennsylvania is May 3-9. During this week Pennsylvania will host a full schedule of events for tourists. Greene County Day will be held at the Welcome Center in Kirby on May 7th and the Washington County Day will be at the Claysville Welcome Center on May 8th. LIONS CLUB OF WAYNESBURG

October, 1940, was the beginning of a great relationship between the people of the greater Waynesburg area and the newly formed Waynesburg Lions Club. The Club was chartered and met in the Fort Jackson Hotel.

The founder of Lions Clubs, Melvin Jones, was a Chicago business man who was meeting for luncheons with other businessmen, when he suggested they should form an association to assist those less fortunate than themselves. Clubs were formed and the first association meeting was held in October, 1917. The association grew by leaps and bounds and soon became international.

Today Lions Clubs International is the largest service organization in the world with 1,425,000 members in 43,724 clubs in 185 countries or geographical areas.

The Waynesburg Lions Club supports the community with donations to various activities and assistance to sight impaired individuals. The Club also supports activities sponsored by the four county district, such as, eye research, diabetes research, beacon lodge, a blind camp near Mt. Union, Pa., and leader dog school of Rochester, Michigan.

The Fourth of July celebration which has become an annual event in Waynesburg is sponsored entirely through the efforts of the Waynesburg Lions Club.

The Lions Community Park, is also financed and administered by the Waynesburg Lions Club.

Funds are raised by conducting Christmas tree sales, Koeze nut sales, broom and trash bag sales, golf tournament and contributions from local businesses and patrons.




