#### **Director's Note**

It was an honor and a pleasure to be able to organize the Company C send-off on March 11th. The turn out from the community was even better than I expected. The weather cooperated and the event went off with only one minor problem. I figured that when I told the Captain that they were not to leave the armory until the bells at the courthouse tolled 4:00pm, I didn't have to worry. You can imagine my surprise to hear the men's voices and footsteps almost 10 minutes early! Even though it began a few minutes early, I was extremely pleased with the event. I've even begun to plan their homecoming ceremony in the back of my mind!

The database of services available to the families has been continually growing and the phone calls and emails regarding care packages are coming in daily. We have posted the news clippings about Company C in our lobby windows and proudly display American flags in our street front windows. I am extremely proud of the response we've received from our Chamber members and the community at large.

And finally, I have to share one of my most favorite experiences from the final days before the men deployed. President of the Family Support Group, and one of my dearest friends, Deanna Cole, called me at the office. We went over several items and then she said "Do you know anyone who sews?" When I asked why, she said that most of the soldiers needed their American Flags and Keystones sewed onto their jackets before they left and only a few had spouses who were able to sew. It seems that sewing is a lost art and she desperately needed help. The very next day, myself, Deanna and Lindsay Blair from my office, sewed patches on so many jackets we lost count. We scoured town looking for thread and pins and our machines went non-stop for several hours. By the time the send-off rolled around at 4:00pm we had everyone ready for their appearance at the courthouse. There was still sewing to be done over the next few days, as each man has more than one jacket that needed the emblems, but we had gotten a very big job done for the men in record time. This experience was by far the most rewarding for me as I got to meet each man I sewed for. Even though each one only spent a matter of minutes in front of my sewing machine, I was finally able to put faces to the people I had been working for weeks to honor. And for that, I thank Deanna. And I applaud her for all she has done and is doing to help the men and their families and for allowing me to be just a small part of this very special effort.

This is the thirteenth year the Chamber will award the \$1,500 scholarship. The scholarship program is open to any Greene County student who will be graduating from high school this spring.


The Chamber urges all high school seniors who have been accepted to a College or Technical School as an incoming freshman this Fall and have maintained a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better while in high school to apply for this scholarship.

Applicants will be required to write an essay on "What is your purpose in life and how do you plan to address this purpose through your education." Applicants must also furnish a listing of their school activities and local community involvement that will be used in the event of a tie. Applications are available at each County High School and the Greene County Vo-Tech or can be obtained by calling the Chamber of Commerce office at 724-627-5926.

Completed applications must be submitted by 4:00 pm on Thursday, April 24th. The winner will be announced May 14th and the Scholarship Award presented at the Chamber's monthly General Membership Meeting on May 28th.
