### \$1,500.00 CHAMBER OF COMMERCE EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Chamber will kickoff its annual Educational Scholarship Fund Award the week of February 16th. Greene County schools will receive letters and applications. The criteria for application consideration is:

- 1. Student must reside in Greene County.
- 2. Student must be a graduating member of a high school class of 1998.
- Student must have maintained a cumulative grade point average of a 3.0 minimum.
- Student must have applied and been accepted to the College or Technical School of their choice as an incoming Freshman.
- A Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance (PHEA) form must be completed through the Financial Aid Office at the college they plan to attend. Demonstrable financial need as determined from the form is required.

There are additional instructions in the applications. Applications must be completed and returned to the Chamber office no later than April 15th. The scholarship recipient will be notified by April 30th.
