THANK YOU

GEORGEANN GARDNER AND ROSALIND LAUR, JURY COMMIS-SIONERS for their informative presentation to the General Membership on November 20th. Rosalind and Georgeann talked and answered questions about the Greene County jury selection process. Each year in January, the jury commissioners of Greene County fill the jury wheel with 1,200-1,500 names of citizens of Greene County. As they need a cross section of jurors, they use a number of sources. Our justice system is based on a trial by a jury of one's peers. It is just the luck of the draw as to who is chosen for jury duty. They have people tell them they have never been called and would like to serve. They also have people who have served tell them they would like to serve again; a juror is permitted to serve every three years. The Civil and Criminal Court terms in our County are called into session quarterly— February, May, August and November. The average case will run three days. Jurors receive \$9 per day for the first three days and \$25 a day thereafter, plus mileage. With the cooperation of the Waynesburg Boro, free parking is provided. In order to serve, one must be a US citizen, 18 years of age or older, able to read, write and understand English, be physically and mentally capable of serving, and never been convicted of a crime. It is not true that you must be registered to vote in order to be called for jury duty. If you would like to serve, you should call their office at 852-5231 and give them you name and address. They encourage you to pass along this information to your family and friends and have them call their office. If you are called for jury duty, they hope you will look forward to it and they assure you, the experience will be enlightening and interesting. If you have any questions, please give them a call!


