

# MISS RAIN DAY PAGEANT A RAGING SUCCESS "SUNDAY NIGHT FEVER . . . the DISCO YEARS"



Environmental Variables •Service Configuration changes: -SNU -Geo-Psych -Ambulatory Surgery -Redesign M/S Floor -Ambulatory Service (Radiology, etc.) •Medical Staff Enhancements and state of the art improvement and replacement of ER physicians: -Ophthalmology -Orthopedic -ENT -Cardiology -Pulmonology -Neurology -Nephrology -Urology -OB/Gyn. Mr. Walsh is a very amiable and earnest speaker and delivered a most informative and direct presentation. Numerous members asked questions and generally were very pleased with the explanations and discussions regarding the future of Greene County Memorial Hospital.
