



College Receives Technical Compliance Review

Waynesburg College has received notification from the PA Department of Education that the College's education department is in full compliance with Chapter 354 Technical Assistance standards.

According to Education Department Chairman Frank Pazzynski, "This review verifies that our Department is in compliance with all the State standards, which means our program, curriculum, and faculty are part of a professional educator program. The Department is proactive when creating a supportive learning environment for our current students and future teachers."

Standards evaluated included: a college mission statement to match a professional teacher philosophy; available reporting process to improve the department's programs; admissions process to support those future teachers; program design to enable students to complete the certification process in a timely manner; field experiences to integrate academic and classroom practice into meaningful learning; student teaching experiences; collaboration with the education community; and advising systems to monitor students' progress.

The College also met the standards for its professional development support of the faculty.

Waynesburg College Teaching Excellence Awards Presented At Graduation

During graduation ceremonies, Dr. Jack (John) Cummings, professor of Biology, and Frank Pazzynski, associate professor of Education, received the Lucas-Hathaway Teaching Excellence Awards for their outstanding contributions to the College.

Funded by the Lucas-Hathaway Charitable Trust, the Teaching Excellence Awards recognize accomplishments in two categories: faculty with a consistent history of teaching excellence and faculty who have achieved excellence in introductory courses.

Receiving recognition for a consistent history of teaching excellence specifically in upper level courses, Cummings joined the Waynesburg College faculty in 1968. He has a Bachelor of Science degree from Bowling Green University and a Ph.D. from Northwestern University. Cummings is the Chairman of the Biology, Chemistry, Geology & Sports Medicine Department. In the classroom, Dr. Cummings encourages advanced scholarship.

Under Cumming's leadership the new Marine Biology major was created, and he was involved in the development of the Athletic Training major. Cummings also chairs the faculty handbook committee. Dr. Cummings enjoys carpentry as a hobby and uses his skills to assist local Habitat for Humanity projects.

Recognized for teaching excellence in introductory courses, Associate Professor Frank Pazzynski joined the Waynesburg College faculty in 1985 and has taught at all levels at the College. He has a Bachelor and Master degrees from West Virginia University.

Pazzynski's enthusiasm for teaching is notable, and recently he presented a teaching session for adjunct faculty. He is recognized for his ability to engage beginning students and identify students who have potential as future teachers. Professor Pazzynski is active in campus ministries and the College spring musicals. He frequently accompanies his wife, Lisa, a vocalist. He plays guitar, banjo, harmonica, bass or keyboard at College functions and local community events. He recently served as a chaperone for the spring European tour with the Lamplighters. He is Chair of the Education Department.

ADSL and Internet Order Process

ALLTEL ADSL and Internet Order Process

- 1) MAKE SURE YOU FAX THE FORM TO THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE! The chamber will only get credit for the referral if you fax that form to them.
- 2) Once you have faxed that form, dial **1-800-ALLTEL-7** (1-800-255-8357) to place your order for ALLTEL Internet Services.
- 3) For Internet Service, a customer service rep will take your order and mail you the ALLTEL Internet information packet. That information will include your username and password as well as the free ALLTEL Internet software, which includes Internet Explorer, Cyber Patrol Parental Control Software, and Netscape Navigator.
- 4) Follow the instructions for setting up your computer, and contact our **Internet Customer Care**Center if you have any problems. They are available **24 hours a day, 7 days a week**. They can be contacted at 800-990-4449.
- 1) If you are interested in ordering ADSL service, dial 1-800-ALLTEL-7 (1-800-255-8357).
- 2) For ADSL Service, a customer service rep will take your order information and have your telephone line qualified. Qualification of a line is a test that verifies that your telephone line is within the recommended area for ADSL service. A positive qualification test does not guarantee that ADSL will work at your location, but it does indicate that you are within the established limits. Qualification usually takes about 2 days.
- 3) Once your line has been qualified, a service rep will call you back to verify your order. If you are interested in signing a contract for a **free or discounted router**, then the service representative will fax or mail that to you. If you sign a contract, the activation is **free**.
- 4) After your order has been verified (or after we receive your contract, if applicable), the work order is placed. Usually orders are completed within 10 business days.
- 5) You should receive your ADSL modem kit prior to or on your service date. Follow the instructions included with the kit for setting up and configuring your ADSL modem and your computer. (NOTE: Your computer is required to have an Ethernet card to connect to the Cisco 67x included in the modem kit.)
- 6) On your due date, the service should be installed prior to 5 p.m. EST.
- 7) If you have any problems with your service, we have an **ADSL Help Desk** that is ready to take your calls **24 hours a day, 7 days a week**. They can be contacted at **1-888-292-3827**.


