## Harrisburg Hope

- Harrisburg legislators in the Pennsylvania House of Representatives continue to debate House Bill 2216, which would provide the PA business community with much needed workers' compensation cost relief. Chamber members are encouraged to contact your elected officials in both the House and Senate to discuss the importance of bringing down the exorbitant costs of workers' comp in our state. HB 2216 has been referred to the House Labor Relations Committee.
- The PA Chamber of Business & Industry advises that some lawmakers have proposed "Any Willing Provider" legislation which attacks managed care. The legislation would forcibly allow any physician who is willing to accept HMO pricing schedules to treat HMO patients without adhering to the "supply/demand" arrangements of the HMO managed care network. While this is great for physicians who can't compete with the cost-saving HMO plans, the costs of health care for businesses could rise 20%! The Chamber is leading the fight to make sure that lawmakers understand the serious consequences of this legislation for PA business.
