The office is now accepting applications from graduating seniors for the 16th Annual Chamber of Commerce Scholarship that will be awarded this May. The scholarship program is open to any Greene County student who will be a graduating senior in 2006. All high school seniors who have been accepted to a College or Technical School as an incoming freshman this Fall and have maintained a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better while in high school are urged to apply for this scholarship. SOUTHWEST REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER ICU OPEN FOR BUSINESS

After nearly four months of planning and preparation, the Southwest Regional Medical Center Intensive Care Unit is now fully functional. The Intensive Care Unit is now accepting admissions after being surveyed by the Pennsylvania Department of Health on Tuesday, February 28. The occupancy permit was issued after the inspection was completed with no deficiencies. The Intensive Care Unit adds five new beds and will expand the hospitals continuum of care, providing greater benefits to patients and the community. Patients admitted to the unit will receive constant monitoring and care. The medical and nursing staff is specially trained to provide the services required by these patients. Complementing the opening of the ICU is the addition of Dr. Manuel Bautista who will serve as the Hospitalist for Southwest Regional. As Hospitalist, Dr. Bautista will work full time at the hospital. He will assist the medical staff in coordinating care for patients admitted to SRMC. This is especially relevant for patients in the Intensive Care Unit, who require additional attention and services during their stay at Southwest Regional.

Southwest Regional Medical Center is a community based 59 bed hospital, providing 24 hour emergency services, a skilled nursing unit, diagnostic imaging, laboratory, physical therapy, cardiology and home health services, in addition to comprehensive surgical programs. Founded in 1907, the hospital was purchased by Essent Healthcare on October 12, 2005.

Juvenile delinquency and inner city problems are depicted through music and dance. While their family and friends disapprove, Tony and Maria try to share their love for each other.
