A happy dog needs a change of scenery everyday that's why at PaPa Bear's Doggy Den, a family operated dog boarding and daycare facility, we developed the cageless kennel concept. We believe that we offer something different than other dog kennels in the area. We built simple small rooms with drywall construction, hospital grade vinyl floors and screened windows. The rooms are huge by most kennel standards. Our smallest kennel is 4' x 8'. If that isn't enough room for your pet to roam; we presently have four 4' x 30' natural gravel and grass runs that our guests really enjoy. We also have a 20' round play yard adjacent to a 6' x 8' room that we developed especially for multi-pet or giant breed families. In our itinerary, each day each guest enjoys play time away from the Doggy Den. To meet that need we built two 60' x 120' fenced grass and garden play yards. When the weather is not cooperative we have a 28' x 40' romper room complete with couches and chairs. Lastly we would not think of keeping your pet without giving them a good dose of one on one time. Each evening every dog in the building received a relaxing period of quiet attention and a good night tuck-in snack. Now if you are a dog owner who has boarded before you may be thinking "yeah who can afford that kind of 'doggy spa' treatment? Those places cost an arm and a leg!". Well not at PaPa Bear's. Our costs are in line with many of the cage and concrete places where you have boarded your dog before. We simply offer comfortable accommodations and activities designed to keep your pet content and entertained.
