"Ceremonial Signing of the Constitution and Birthday Party"



Thanks to the County of Greene, the County Events Committee and Jackie Kingora, Tourism Coordinator for coordinating a special ceremony honoring the signing of the Constitution, one of many such signings across America during the week of September 17 -23rd (National Constitutional Week - sponsored by the National Constitution Center in Philadelphia). All signatures will be displayed at the Center and Greene County, for the first time, submitted 1,387 signatures. H. Terry Grimes, President Judge, Congressman Frank Mascara, State Senator J. Barry Stout, Representative H. William DeWeese were eloquent in their salute to our Constitution and Greene County's representation of those values. Greene Countians, along with Commissioners, Coder, Toothman, Gardner and Sheriff Ketchum participated in the festivities and blew out the birthday candles on cakes representing our 200 year birthday.
