

New Coordinator Heading WCCC Greene County Center

With fall classes starting, a new coordinator is heading the Greene County Center of Westmoreland County Community College. Following her appointment by the WCCC board of trustees, Anna E. Petrovich of Waynesburg is overseeing operations of the college's Greene County Center. She replaces Dr. Nancy Davis of Dilliner who now serves as the college's Greene County workforce development coordinator. Previously Petrovich served as the admissions counselor/recruiter for Fairmont State University-Community and Technical College and was the assistant to the human resources manager for Adecco Employment Agency, Washington. She holds a bachelor of arts degree in theatre and television from Susquehanna University, in Sellinsgrove, where she graduated summa cum laude. As coordinator of WCCC's Greene County Center, Petrovich will manage the day-to-day operations of the center, facilitate the enrollment process for students, and act as a liaison between the center and other WCCC sites, as well as represent the center in the community. The Greene County Center is located at 100 EverGreene Drive, EverGreene Technology Park in Waynesburg. The new center, which opened a year ago, houses five general classrooms, two computer classrooms/labs, a videoconferencing classroom, offices, a student lounge and laboratory facilities for the college's Greene County nursing program.
