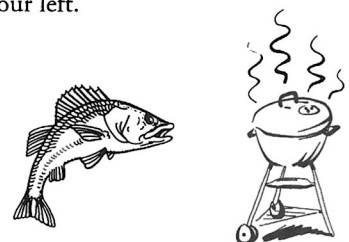

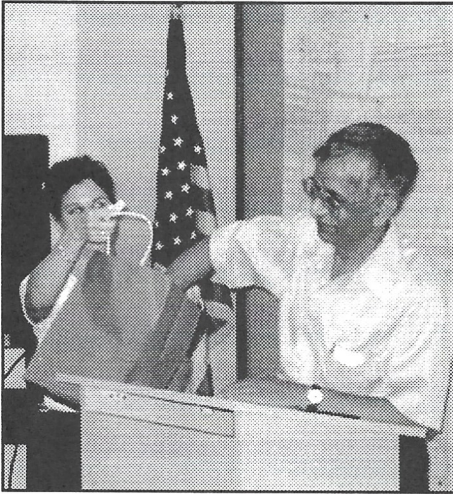

Greene Community Church

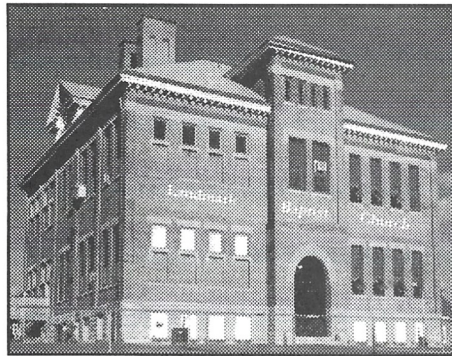

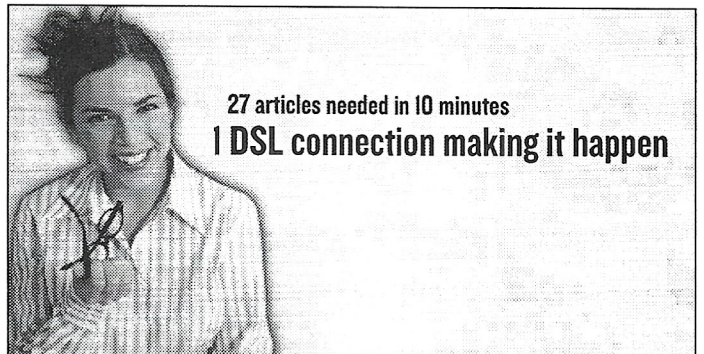

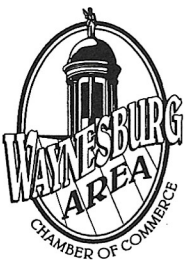
